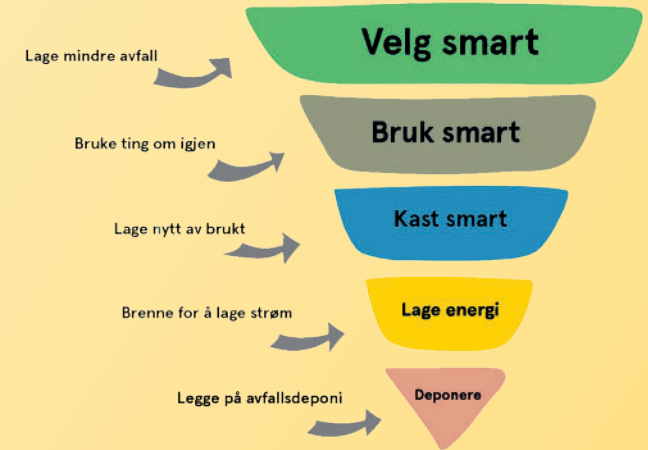

Plastic
packaging

Packaging should be clean and dry

- Plastic bags
- Onion nets
- Shampoo bottles
- Candy wrappers
- Yoghurt containers
- Soap dispenser bottles
- Bottle caps

- Foam rubber
- Contact lenses
- Pill packaging
- Firewood packaging
- Buckets

Non-packaging plastic is to be delivered to a Recycling Station

Yes please

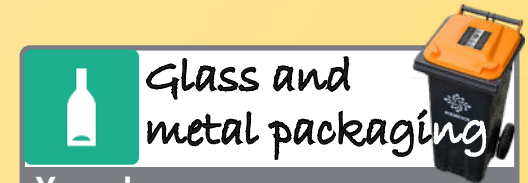
Packaging should be clean and dry

- Envelopes
- News papers
- Egg cartons
- Cardboard boxes
- Books with soft covers
- Letters
- Pizza box

Items considered residual waste:

- Paper cups and -plates
- Wet paper
- Scratch cards
- Shiny wrapping paper
- Receipts
- Napkins



Glass and
metal packaging

Yes please


Do not wrap it in plastic bags,
put it straight in the container

- Glass jars
- Aluminum foil
- Metal caps
- Soft metal cans
- Beer-/soda cans without pant
- Tin cans
- Metal tubes
- Glass bottles

Recycling Station:

- Porcelain
- Pottery
- Frying pans
- Casseroles
- Paint buckets
- Crystal
- Mirrors
- Cutlery
- Car parts
- Drinking glasses



Residual waste

- Diapers and pads
- Contact lenses

Other types of waste



Electronic waste

Electric/electronic waste (EE-waste) as for instance **PC, TV, og refridgerators** can be returned for free to shops selling the equipment or to our Remiks Recycling stations. **Light up shoes, electric toys, mobile phones, hairdryer, razers and all sorts of light bulbs** are also EE-waste.



Hazardous waste

Hazardous waste includes **paint, lacquer, glue and thinner, oil, batteries and gass driven spray cans**. This should be delivered at Remiks Recycling stations. Please pack it in closed containers or original wrapping om delivery.



Clothes

Small containers are to be found in the municipality. This service is run by the organisations UFF og Fretex See www.uffnorge.no and www.fretex.no for info.



Garden waste

Garden waste should be sorted into three parts and delivered to the Recycling station:
Part 1: Twigs, branches, tops and trees (max 10 cm)
Part 2: Grass, moss, leafs, no sand/gravel (up to 30 cm)
Part 3: Soil, sand og stone.



Furniture - 2.hand store

Reusable furniture and other objects can be delivered at Remiks Bruktbutikk or other 2.hand stores. Read more on: www.remiks.no/bruktbutikken/



If your goods are not suitable for reuse, please deliver them to one of our Recycling stations.

Deliver it all - in one place

On our recycling stations you can deliver it all, including residual waste and goods for reuse. Our guides will help you with the sorting.

Deliver your waste close to home

Our mobile recycling stations accept the amount of waste you can carry with you. We do not accept residual waste, but bring with your both paper and plastic, cardboard and batteries, light bulbs and wood, metal and electronics. Also goods for reuse are welcome.

Do you sort your waste before you drive to the Recycling Station?

A good tip is to sort your waste even before you travel to the Recycling Station. It will save you money.

A lot of your waste can be delivered free of charge at our Recycling stations, such as **glass, electronic waste, rubber, metal, reusable goods, dangerous waste, paper/carton and impregnated wood. Non-packaging plastic (toys, plastic flowers etc.) is also to be delivered to a Recycling Station.**

Our skilled idvisers will help you get things right when you arrive.

As a household customer of Remiks you can also deliver a certain amount of residual waste at the Recycling station. You have already payed for this through the renovation fee charged by the municipality
